The 27th Metropolis Canada Conference Steering Committee is pleased to announce the opening of our call for nominations for the Metropolis Canada Awards. These awards recognize and celebrate outstanding contributions to the field of immigration and settlement in Canada.

The National Metropolis awards intend to establish a benchmark of achievement and excellence, bringing pride and peer acknowledgement to the deserving recipients. There are three award categories to nominate candidates under:

- National Metropolis Service Provider Award (Non-profit)
- National Metropolis Researcher Award (Academic/Graduate Student)
- National Metropolis Policymaker Award (Former/Current Civil Servant)

The Metropolis Awards Subcommittee, consisting of members of the Conference Steering Committee, is responsible for selecting the Award recipients. A nomination for each of the three categories of the Metropolis Awards may be submitted by any persons working in the field of immigration and settlement in Canada and should include:

- A one-page statement explaining reasons for the nomination.
- A copy of the nominee's full curriculum vitae.
- And two letters of recommendation.
